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Information for carriers, importers and customs declarants

▪ New Auto-IMP functions also for IMP StatusRequest

The Auto-IMP functions have been extended within the previous release 6.8.0. As of now the new features are also available for the IMP StatusRequest, roles 'Customs declarant' and 'Combined'.

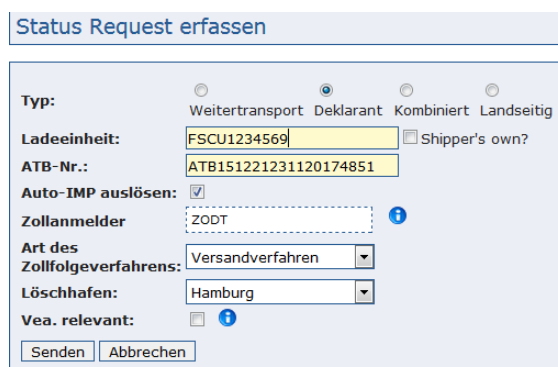
Following features have been expanded (only for Hamburg as port of discharge):

- Sending a prepared NCTS-operation
- Sending a prepared customs declaration (DEHAM) including veterinary relevant goods

A short overview of those features:

Sending a prepared NCTS-operations (all ports)

A prepared NCTS-operation can be sent using the Auto-IMP-features. For this purpose you only have to specify the type of NCTS-operation in addition to the Auto-IMP declarant:

Sending a prepared customs declaration (DEHAM) including veterinary relevant goods

You may not lodge a preliminary customs declaration for Shipments with veterinary relevant goods. You could use the auto-IMP-features to send a prepared customs application. You would set a mark for „goods need an declaration with veterinary office“ in addition to the auto-IMP declarant:

The implementation manual of the XML interface „StatusRequest“, version 1.1, will be published soon with all necessary amendments.

Information for shipowners

- **List “SumA differences” available as xlsx file**

Until now the list „SumA differences“ is sent as xls file (Excel 97-2003). As of now it is also available as xlsx format. Please change the configuration under Administration/Mail administration /Discharge/loading order:
