## **Information for carriers and terminals**

## New status 766 within the transshipment process

As already announced in the previous newsletter the available S-number with status "not released" will be automatically cancelled in IMP, if an error occurs during the creation of an exit summary declaration. You will receive a status messages with code 766 ("Storno S-Nummer nach ATLAS-Fehler" / "Cancellation of S-number after ATLAS error"). This error situation should be a rarity. Please get in touch with our support in such cases.

#### **Information for terminals**

#### Processing of shifting containers

Particularly the internal processing of shifters has been revised and existing bugs have been fixed. The editing of container movements in IMP-Direct has been supplemented by the indicator "label is shifter?". The field is assigned with the default value "no" and can only be edited if





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the movement types "discharge information" or "actual loading" are selected in the field "Type of movement".




Image 1: Recording of container movements

Within the overview list you also have the option to specifically search for shifters.

#### New functions for the synchronization of loading order and actual loading

In order to be able to verify whether or not all messages have been processed successfully after the completion of all loadings, you can open a view via the menus "Terminal > loading order/ actual load list", which allows you to comprehend per vessel, if

- an actual loading has been reported for each container (that have been) mentioned in the loading order,
- > and whether a loading order has been reported previously for all loaded containers,
- > and if all summary declarations are now completed due to the re-export notification.

First you reach the overview below where you can display a list with the loading order and actual loadings which have been sent recently per vessel and voyage:





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


Image 2: Overview loading order/actual loading

The detailed view provides an overview about all containers which have been reported to this vessel. By using the filter function you can narrow your search in order to carry out examinations.
