Information for carriers and terminals

ATLAS maintenance works on 10.06.2017

Due to maintenance works the message communication with the ATLAS system will be temporarily interrupted on 10.06.2017 between 1 p.m. and 8 p.m., i.e. during this time no messages from the ATLAS system will be sent to the IMP, nor will it be possible to carry out actions in connection with the summary declaration (confirmation of preliminary ATB no., change of depository, Auto-IMP, re-export). Incoming messages from IMP participants will be received but only be processed after the maintenance works will have been completed.

Technical maintenance works in IMP on 13.06.2017

IMP will not be available on 13.06.2017 between 10:30 p.m. and 00:30 a.m. due to technical maintenance works. During this time incoming messages will be retained as usual and continued to be processed after the maintenance works are completed. Software changes will not be implemented on this date.





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Programme changes

Especially technical improvements have been made with the current version. Maintenance works have been necessary in order to prepare for the technical maintenance work next week. Nevertheless, we would like to point out two changes:

- ➤ <u>IMP-StatusRequest</u>: In case of certain message sequences, the messages 'Delay' and 'Early arrival' were sent so far after the message 'Line secure'. This will be corrected by means of the current release.
- ➤ <u>Transshipment</u>: The change of the vessel operator does no longer leads to the situation that existing B- or S-numbers are cancelled. If you change the transport direction in case of imports from 'Import' to 'Transshipment' an existing ZAPP-declaration will not have to be cancelled, either. Both items of information are not part of the ZAPP declaration, thus the existing ZAPP declaration may remain unchanged in case of these data changes.
