

ZAPP-Circular no. 40

Content

- 1. Only one declaration type per HDS/GM01/Port Order
- 2. New validation for IMDG class 2 in HDS
- 3. Cancellation of B-/S-/Z-numbers that are no longer required

The ZAPP Circular no. 40 provides information about planned changes concerning the ZAPP application and procedural instructions during the declaration.

1. Only one declaration type per HDS/GM01/Port Order

Currently, there can be both an MIT and an SBF presentation of goods in an HDS at the same time.

Due to reasons of complexity this possibility will not longer be permitted as of 24.01.2023 and will be rejected at HDS/GM01/Port Order entry.

2. New validation for IMDG class 2 in HDS

In some cases the UN number 1950 (pressure gas pack) is declared with IMDG class 2 via HDS.

Specifying IMDG class 2 is not sufficient without further additions. The more specific information 2.1, 2.2 or 2.3 is required.

The validation will be adapted on 24.01.2023. A HDS with IMDG class 2 without further additions will then be rejected.

3. Cancellation of B-/S-/Z-numbers that are no longer required

Uncompleted B-/S-/-Z-numbers for which no further export is expected, must be cancelled promptly in order to avoid problems with subsequent presentation of the same container. Otherwise, there is a risk that an old case will be assigned to the container Gate-In that actually belongs to a newer presentation. The newer presentation remains without Gate-In and cannot get a release this way.

For Z-numbers with status "RLS" the export process of the MRN must be cancelled in case the export is cancelled or will be presented to a different export Customs office.
