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With the ZAPP Circular no. 54 we would like to inform you about important changes in the ATLAS re-export control system (WKS) in connection with ZAPP and the new Export Management Platform (EMP).

1. Update to WKS migration

The information concerning the soft migration from EAS to WKS has been adjusted on the webpage [zoll.de](https://www.zoll.de).

30. June 2025, which was previously mentioned as date until which the processing of incoming ASuMA messages in the EAS procedure is guaranteed, is no longer mentioned. The new information states that „the processing of incoming ASuMA messages in the EAS procedure is guaranteed for a transitional period“.

The certification for WKS is possible since the beginning of April. DAKOSY is currently working on the certification for WKS, which will then be followed by integration tests with the ZAPP/EMP WKS solution.

Currently we are also working on a new time schedule for the migration from EAS to WKS via ZAPP/EMP. As soon as the planning is finalised we will inform you in a separate ZAPP circular.

2. Interchange adaptations of WKS

In the ZAPP Circulars [no. 48](#) and [no. 49](#) we informed you about necessary interface changes in preparation for the re-export system (WKS). These interface changes must be implemented promptly.

The additional data is mandatory for the ASuMA declaration in ATLAS WKS and can already be received by the DAKOSY test and productive environments.
