# Review of EDI Interfaces for HHLA Terminals

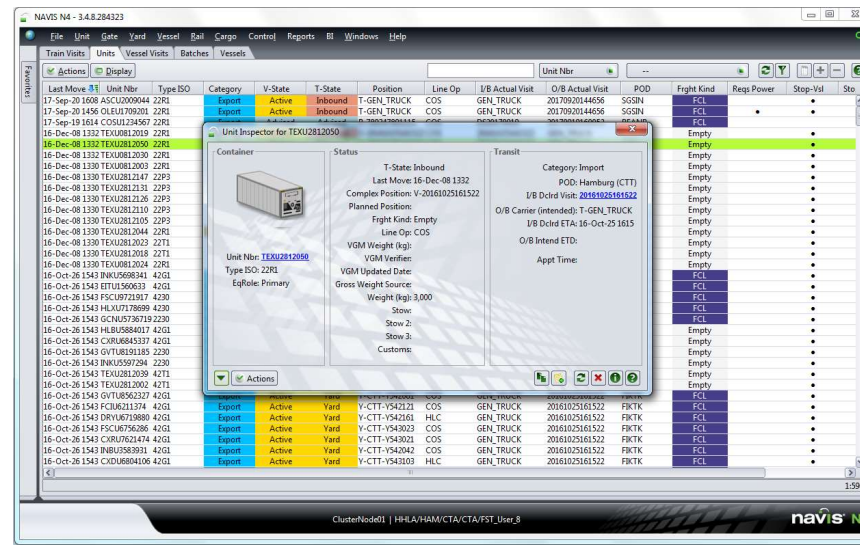
## Goals

- One Terminal Operating System for all three Terminals
- One EDI System with one EDI Interface to the Customer for all three Terminals.
- Use of international Standards only (UN EDIFACT, SMDG) for all business communications processes.
  - Improving Data Quality to help ensuring smooth operations for ultra large container vessels.
  - Optimization of Maintenance and Support (IT and operational)
  - Improve „time to market“ for new features triggered by changes in communication processes.

- Navis N4: established Terminal operating System at over 200 terminals worldwide

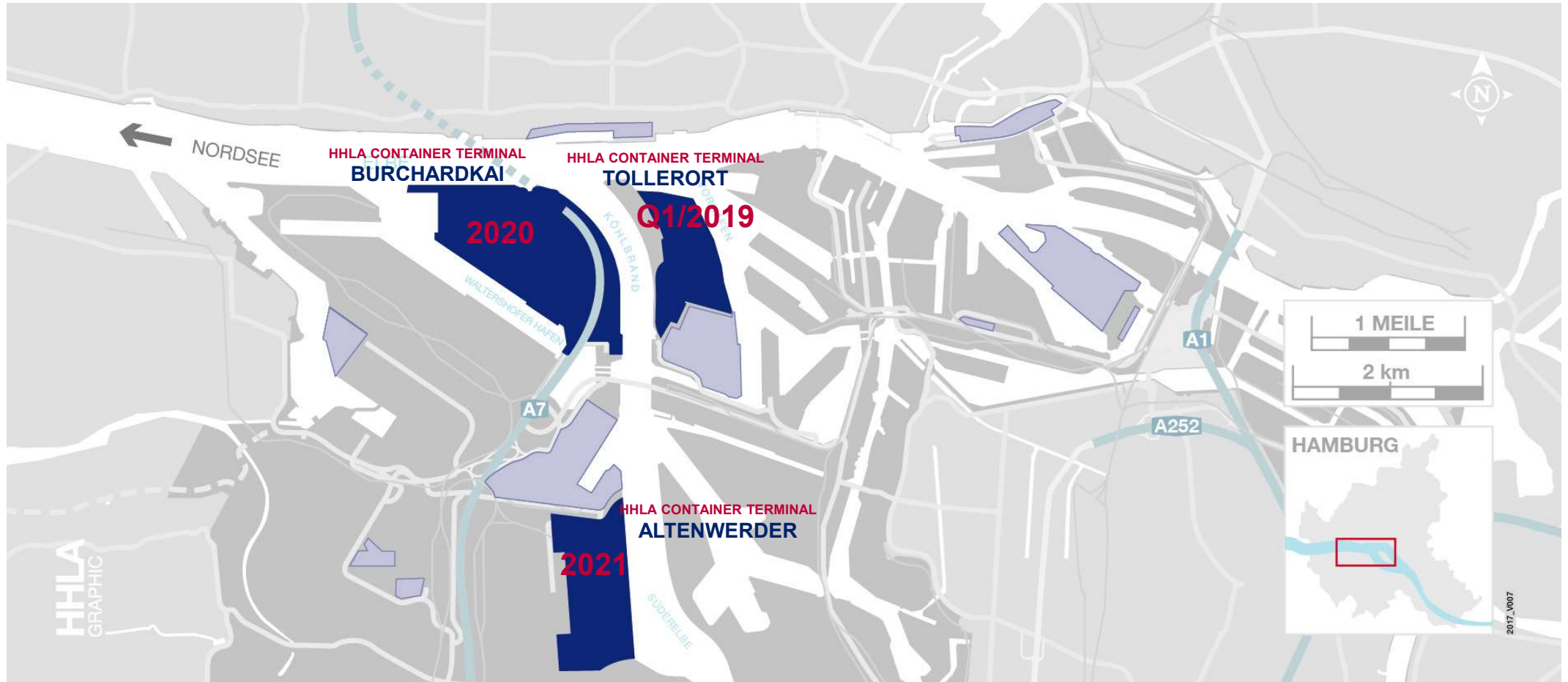


- Seeburger BIS: established EDI Solution across many industries, such as automotive, trade and logistics.

# Review of EDI Interfaces for HHLA Terminals

## IMP Import Operation Instruction

---

For all Terminals with new Terminal Operating System N4 available:

- IMP Import Operation Instruction:
  - Availability of all Container Status Information (Gate In / Out, Release Order, Holds, Customs Status)
  - In future: All Container Status information will be available regardless of whether Import Operation Instruction was sent before or after discharge of container from vessel.
  - But...

# Review of EDI Interfaces for HHLA Terminals

## IMP Import Operation Instruction

---

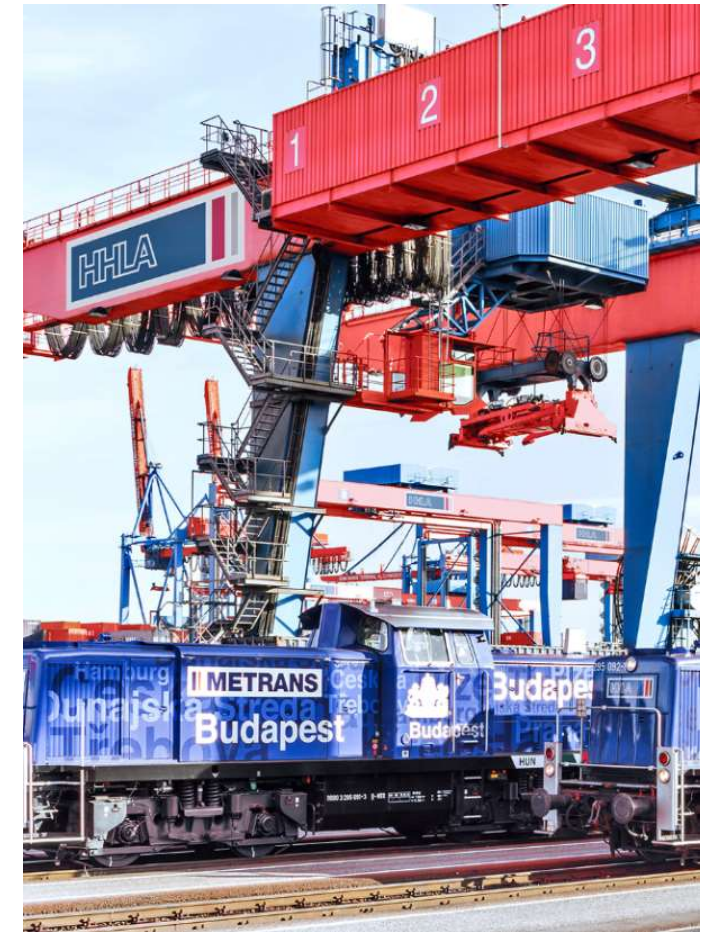
For N4 Go Live at CTT:

- ...functionality for sending Container Status Information by CTT will not be available for two month after N4 Go Live at CTT.
- The following Container Status will not be available for 2 month after Go Live:
  - Container Holds, placed by Terminal
  - Container released (yes/no).

# Roadmap for Go Live of N4

## Q1/2019 Go Live at CTT

- Since beginning of 2019 intensive testing of new system is taking place
- Final GO Live of new terminal operating system on Easter Sunday, the 21.04.2019.
